1 French person out of 6, lives below the poverty line? With a "worrying phenomenon": the increase in the poverty rate of children under 18 (+ 0.1% point to 19.6% who live in single-parent families).

With long-term unemployment hitting the most vulnerable households hardest The poor and the precarious should no longer be considered as a marginal minority more or less responsible for their situation.

The voices of people directly concerned by social difficulties enrich the political proposals with their expertise.

To ensure that all citizens benefit from what they are entitled to, no more and no less. The principle of decompartmentalizing social policies: Coordinating the actions of public, associative and private actors around social support.

The primary resources must be redistributed and allow all peoples to have housing, food and education to promote dignified work and harmonization of relations. For true solidarity and not for the profit of NGOs and political organizations that profit financially from subsidies on the back of a voluntary human disorder. Disorder organized to destabilize the world for the benefit of a financial minority of lobbyists and solidarity with such a financial objective.

It is not a question of recognizing one function more than another, everyone contributes to the functioning of a society.

The universal minimum income

We want to make our social commitment a reality. To do so, we propose the establishment of a departmental and national service of consultation and coordination worthy of our société and which would aim to leave no one by the wayside and to articulate public and associative action.

We think it is urgent to set up a minimum guarantee of existence. Without resources to live and to continue socio-professional activities (volunteering, activities or work, job search), wondering day after day if we will manage to make ends meet, such has been the struggle of thousands of citizens of France for 4 decades.

Several collectives in France have déjà launched petitions but they do not carry enough weight, and the social misery, the abuse that accompanies it, as well as the after-effects on health and social welfare, taxpayers, etc. (sécurité) become more pronounced.

We therefore propose the introduction of the RMU (Universal Minimum Income): an income with no conditions (neither age, origin, nor support). It is the certainty of a minimum to eat and live in order to find its place in the société. The dignité is the human.

But we also need to invent <u>a UNIVERSAL DIVIDEND</u> in place of the various forms of "income from existence" that have been exposed so far. The idea is based on the observation that the current great fortunes have been built up over the centuries on the work produced by employees always underpaid or even reduced to slavery sometimes or enlisted for the benefit of the occupier, thus diverted to the benefit of a few at the expense of the multitude of all the others. Certainly its fortunes were for the most virtuous invested in the means of production, but also in purely speculative or rentier adventures. These investments are therefore the property of previous generations who bequeathed them to the present generations. It is therefore appropriate that the dividends currently paid to very few rich shareholders should be paid to all citizens present in the territories. This "universal dividend" would thus be disconnected from the notion of an income linked to work or a pension and the "non-income" linked to unemployment.

Agriculture spearheads to keep the countryside alive and fraternal

It shapes the local economy, the environment and the landscapes of our territories. It must allow every citizen to have access to quality food. Awareness of the link between quality food, health and the environment is an essential asset to change practices and put an end to intensive agriculture.

Food raises essential strategic issues: food and health security, national independence. It is not a commodity!

The prices paid to producers must cover the costs of production but also ensure sufficient income to enable them to have their full place in society.

One third of the water used in Europe is destined for the agricultural sector. There is an urgent need for our planet to change our entire agricultural system.

Avoiding recession

- Bypassing private banks to finance the bulk of public debt,
- Putting an end to European tax dumping, creating a European tax on dividends
- Fighting radically against tax havens
- Securing employees and job seekers, fighting against layoffs
- Create a real tax on financial transactions
- Fighting relocation and enforcing compliance with social and environmental standards in world trade

Fight radically against unemployment and precariousness by creating a new development model.

- Reduction of working time (4-day week)
- Streamline transportation
- To organize on the national territory of the ecological industrial poles of production.
- Systematize the purchase of ecological agricultural products through public procurement for collective catering.
- Using contracts negotiated locally by local authorities ("short circuits")
- Challenging the liberalization of markets, promoted by the WTO, in favor of fair trade that is closer to consumers,
- To finally build a social and democratic Europe with a health commissioner.
